



Certified Evaluation & Management Coder (CEMC) Specialty Course

This course was developed by the American Academy of Professional Coders to help prepare E/M auditors, billers and other medical office professionals for the CEMC examination. It provides an overall review of coding and compliance information for the more experienced coder, as well as for individuals preparing for the CEMC examination. The course is designed to enable working coders to demonstrate superior levels of expertise in E/M auditing.

This 10-hour course is followed by 5½ hour proctored examination made up of 150 multiple choice questions. Upon successful completion of the examination, the student will earn the CEMC specialty credential.

The CEMC credential stands alone, no pre-requisite that the examinee hold a CPC, CPC-H or CPC-P credential is required. An examinee must have experience in E/M coding and/or auditing.

To participate, the following books are required: ICD-9-CM, CPT (Professional or Standard version only) and HCPCS Level II.
