

PSO application service provider (ASP) hosting service for the eCW product

The system is functioning at a very high level and remains very cost effective for practices of all sizes.

The PSO ASP service is a robust, state-of-the-art hardware environment specifically developed and maintained to run the eCW system. Over the years, the PSO has made significant investment and has worked very closely with eCW and Lifespan IS to ensure the environment is operational, available, and secure, providing a low cost hardware solution for our users. Practices utilizing the ASP service have typically realized a 30% savings in up-front project costs and a reduction in recurring operating costs associated with their EMR system maintenance.

Cost:

- Direct via eClinicalWorks \$100.00 per month
- Lifespan Physicians PSO members \$50.00 per month
- Non PSO members \$75.00 per month

Grant Program

- The first 100 physicians to sign on with EHRRI and the PSO ASP will receive a \$1,000.00 grant.
(maximum 10 physicians per practice)
- The next 500 physicians to sign on with EHRRI and the PSO ASP will receive a \$500.00 grant.
(maximum 10 physicians per practice)
This rebate is payable by the Lifespan Physicians PSO after final payment to EHRRI, provided the physician had an EHRRI implementation plan and all providers and staff participate in the minimum eClinicalWorks training program.

Note: Eligibility in the PSO EMR grant program requires participants to be members of The Lifespan / Physicians PSO for a period of at least 12 months prior to application for the funds.

PSO Loan Funding

PSO Loan Fund: If you wish, the PSO will purchase a license from EHRRI and allow you to pay for it on a monthly basis over a three-year period, at the minimum interest rate allowed by Federal law. This program is only available to practices of 12 physicians or less. If you decide not to continue with eCW, you only have to pay for the months that you used the product provided the physician had an EHRRI implementation plan and all providers and staff participate in the minimum eClinicalWorks training program. *

Note: Eligibility in the PSO EMR loan program requires participants to be members of The Lifespan / Physicians PSO for a period of at least 12 months prior to application for the funds.
